water splashed all over.



"What can we do?"


Victor started to laugh.

"Tell me when I'm getting close?" Hanna asked.


"You're close", answered Sarah's mother.

All the children started to go round and round the chairs which were placed in a circle.


Suddenly Anna Sofia's mother opened the door.
